### Moët & Chandon White Star Extra Dry

*Champagne, France.* Beautiful fruit and elegance, refreshing, dry, long finish. 59.00

## WHITE WINES

### Chateau Ste. Michelle Marier Sauvignon Blanc

*Columbia Valley.* Crafted in an Old World style, this incredibly complex Sauvignon Blanc exudes aromas of sweet hay and grass. On the palate, it delivers crisp new world style gooseberry flavors. 29.00

### Sonoma-Cutrer Russian River Ranches Chardonnay

*California.* Clean, tropical fruit, great balance, light vanilla oak finish. (half bottle) 19.50 / 39.00

### King Estate Pinot Gris

*Willamette Valley.* Aromas of ripe melon, pear, honeysuckle, tangerine/pineapple, and nutmeg spice. Rich, ripe fruits with concentrated flavors of tropical, stone fruits and citrus. (half bottle) 19.50 / 39.00

### Chateau Ste. Michelle Canoe Ridge Chardonnay

*Columbia Valley.* Ripe apple and cinnamon spice aromas with an elegant, lingering, sweet citrus finish. 39.00

### Stags' Leap Winery Chardonnay

*Napa Valley.* Beautiful creamy mouthfeel, citrus notes, very elegant style. 44.00

## RED WINES

### Canoe Ridge Merlot

*Columbia Valley.* An elegant supple wine with the finesse of a Pinot Noir and lush fruit characteristics of Canby raspberry, Bing cherries and shaved Belgian chocolate. 32.00

### Montevina Terra d'Oro Zinfandel

*Amador County.* Bold and expressive with dark berry and cracked spice aromas. Flavors of ripe plum, cocoa and sweet oak. 34.00

### Chateau Ste. Michelle Canoe Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon

*Columbia Valley.* Delivers black cherry fruit, spicy oak, leather and sweet caramel characters. Its soft, elegant, slightly dusty finish is typical of Canoe Ridge Estate. This wine shows the more "subtle" side of Washington Cabernet. 36.00

### King Estate Pinot Noir

*Willamette Valley.* Hints of cranberry and cherry on the nose with a silky entry and fruitfulness on the palette. Fruit forward with flavors of cherry and blueberry, hints of vanilla, menthol and cocoa spice round out the lingering finish. 46.00

### L'Ecole N° 41 Cabernet Sauvignon

*Columbia Valley.* With a classic varietal Cabernet profile, this richly structured and integrated wine shows blackberry, cassis and complex leather aromas with flavors of ripe plum, bittersweet chocolate, black cherry and currants on an earthy, spicy finish. (half bottle) 23.95 / 48.00

### The McNab Red Blend by Bonterra

*Mendocino County.* Deep garnet black color with a purple rim. Caramelized nuts, buttercream, spice bag and currant jam aromas. A round supple entry leads to a dryish medium full body of tangy currant, black cherry vanilla bean, brown sugar and spice flavors. 56.00

### Stags' Leap Winery Petite Syrah

*Napa Valley.* The rich aromatics of this wine include ripe black fruit, black currants, cocoa and hints of vanilla. A very full and voluptuous mouthfeel. 59.00
